


### Button

- Emergency Broadcast Button: Click the button to quickly initiate a full-area emergency broadcast.
- HOME Button: Click the button to display the main page. Click the button to enter specific function pages.
- Listening Button: Click the button to enter the listening page for accurately restoring the overall effect of on-site sound. After selecting a terminal, click the button to initiate listening.
- Intercom Button: Click the button to enter the intercom page. After selecting a terminal, click the button to initiate intercom.
- Back Button: Click the button to return to the previous page.
- Broadcast Button: Click the button to enter the broadcast page. During real-time speaking, click the button to initiate broadcasting.
- Reset Button: Press and hold for 5 seconds to automatically restart the device and restore it to factory settings.

### Knob

- MIC Volume Adjustment: For adjusting the MIC input volume of the device.
- AUX Volume Adjustment: For adjusting the AUX input volume of the device.
- MAIN Volume Adjustment: When the device is in broadcast mode, the MAIN volume adjusts the input source volume. When the device is in intercom or listening mode, it adjusts the local output volume.

### Interface

- Gooseneck Microphone Interface: For connecting a gooseneck microphone.
- MIC Input Interface: 3.5 mm audio input interface for connecting an active microphone.
- AUX Input Interface: 3.5 mm audio input interface for connecting devices such as mobile phones and computers.
- LINE Output Interface: For connecting active speakers or amplifiers.
- USB Interface: USB 2.0 interface for inserting a USB drive to play files or copy files from the USB drive to the management device's material library.
- Alarm Interface: 1 alarm input and 1 alarm output.
- Debug Interface: For professional debugging only.
- Network Interface: For network connection.
- Power Interface: 12 VDC power input.


## 2 Installation



- Before installation, check if the power supply meets the device's requirements.
- Complete the wiring before installation. Refer to Chapter 1 for specific interfaces.
- Make sure the device is power-off during the installation.


### Install Gooseneck Microphone (Standard)

Insert the gooseneck microphone into the gooseneck microphone interface and tighten it to complete the installation.



### Desktop Installation

Place the device on a stable desktop to complete the installation.



### Warning

- Refer to the device label for the standard power supply. Please make sure your power supply matches with your device.

## 3 Quick Setup

You should activate the device before the first login. After powering on the device, the system will switch to Device Activation page.

### ● Activate Device

1. Power on the device. It will enter the activation page automatically.
2. Create a password and confirm it.
3. Tap **OK** to activate the device.



We highly recommend you change the password of your own choosing (using 8 to 16 characters, including at least two kinds of following categories: letters, numbers, and symbols) in order to increase the security of your product.

### ● Network Configuration

After activation, tap **System** -> **Engineering Configuration (Enter administrator password)** -> **Network Management** to enter the configuration interface.

Set network parameters.

- Edit Local IP Address, Subnet Mask and Gateway parameters.
- Enable DHCP, the device will get network parameters automatically.
